Warm ups will be 5 and 5 for the first match of the day and then 3 and 3 after that. 3 Team pools will play a cross over match that will also be 2 out of 3. Please confirm reffing assignments before you leave each site and

for the day. There will be a day official for this event. There will be a tournament director at both schools. Prizes will be awarded for U12, U14 & U16 1st Place & 2nd Place.

CONCESSIONS & T-SHIRT VENDOR

There maybe a food concessions on site and a T-shirt vendor on site at both schools. These are invited vendors and are not being run by Yakima Elite Volleyball Club. Please do business on your own and YEVBC is not responsible for any purchases or transactions.

SPORTSMANSHIP AWARDS - Pool Play Only U12 & U14

There will be a sportsmanship award given to a player on each team from the opposite team. This will be left on the scoring desk before each Pool Play match. Please make sure you award a prize before leaving at the end of each match. The tournament director will explain in detail.

ALL TOURNAMENT TEAM - U16 ONLY

6 Players will be chosen for the all tournament team. Awards will be given to the coach prior to the end of the tournament.

This gym is located on Zier before you get to the High School. You may park along the east side of the gym these doors will be closer to gym entrance.






