## TOURNAMENT & FACILITY RULES

- Entry fee \$5 for Adults \$3 for 12-17 yr olds. Free for kids 11 & under
- Tournament format: 2- 3 Team Pools - 3 Games to 25 (No Cap) 2 - 4 Team Pools - 2/3 sets 2 sets to 25 (No cap) 3rd set to 15 (no cap)
- Bracket play 2/3 3rd set to 15 (no cap)
- Warm ups for the first two matches of each pool will be 5/5 and 3/3 for the remaining pool and bracket matches (includes serving time)
- PLEASE KEEP GYMS CLEAR FOR PLAYING. All teams can find a designated team area in the wrestling room @ the HS. If you are at IRMS we will have the cafeteria open for designated team areas. Please keep food in those areas. NO FOOD IN GYM especially parents, please no food. NO food in the wrestling room.
- Water, Gatorade are ok in the gym. Coffees also OK!
- Masks required at all times, unless the team is on court playing. Coaches it will be your responsibility to enforce and monitor your team.
- Coaches/Adults will need to R1. Please keep the game moving in a timely manner. Please bring your own whistle. We will have a few extra.
- Clorox wipes will be at all refing tables, please wipe down line judging flags, table and ball.

- Tie Breakers:
  - Three-Way Ties - If 3 or more teams are tied in match record for first or second place in a pool, the ties are broken by applying the following steps, in order, without repeating

any step. Head-to-Head results will not be used at any time in breaking a three-way tie:

- 1. Determine each team's set percentage (divide each team's total sets won in the pool by the total sets the team played). The team with the highest set percentage is first.
- 2. If some or all of the teams have the same set percentage, then determine the point percentage (divide each team's total points scored by the total points scored by all the team's opponents in that pool).
  - a. Of the teams still tied, the team with the highest point percentage has the next highest finish in the pool (finishes either first or second, depending on the outcome of the set percentage).
- 3. If two or more teams are still tied:
  - a. Coin toss
- Two-Way Ties - If a two-way tie exists, the tie will be broken using the head to head match result

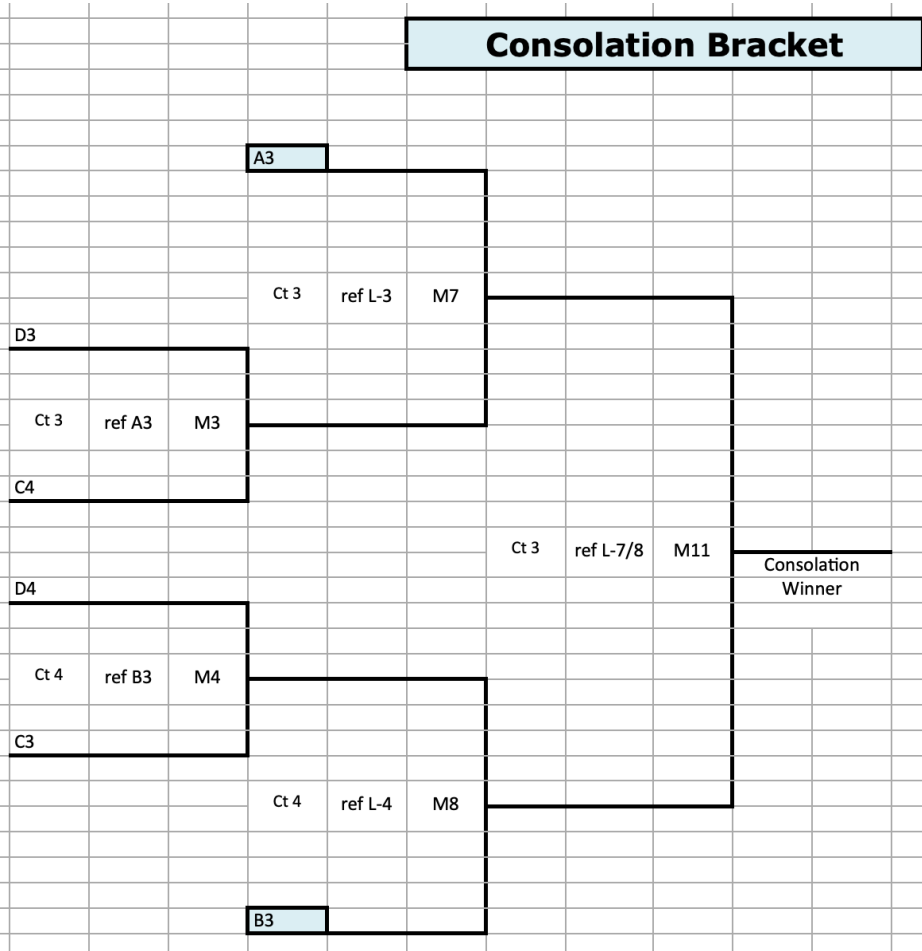
