Playing Site: Riverside Schools | Middle, Elementary & HS | Chattaroy, WA

The schools are all adjacent to each other.

Start Time: 8:00 am – doors open @ 7:00 am

Check-In Procedure:

- Coach will check in at designated check in area in gym with a **PRINTED SportsEngine Roster. (NO EXCEPTIONS)**

GENERAL

- **MASKS are required indoors except while eating or drinking, during play/coaching or officiating. Please adhere to the policy so we can continue to use the facilities during this time.**
- This year I will be allowing beverages in the gyms, but ABSOLUTELY NO FOOD.
- The only exception to this rule is if there is a documented medical condition on the player's medical form.
- No pets are allowed in the gym or inside the school buildings
- No electrical appliances with team coolers.
- Middle School Team cooler areas will be available in the hallways. Please leave a path open on one side of the hallway.
- High School Team cooler areas will be available upstairs.
- School vending machines will be unplugged or taped up per instructions from the school. Please do not try to use them.
- If there are issues around the bathrooms, please notify the site director. There will be a site director in the middle school and at the high school.
- Please, clean your area during the tournament, and before you leave. This will allow us to continue to use these great facilities.
- Please supervise all children.

FORMAT

Warm-ups are 5-5 for the first two rounds of pool play, and then 3-3 after that. Serving must be done within this time.

Officiating Assignments R1's ARE provided, R2's, line judges and scorekeeping crews. **Please have an adult R2 all pool play and bracket play matches.**

If we ask your local team to fill a ref assignment for an out-of-town team to travel home, please be willing to assist.

If your team is asked to ref in the 1st round of pool play to get matches going versus waiting for a late pool, please be willing to do so to keep the matches on time as much as possible.

Pool Play

- Pool play matches best 2/3 with the 3rd set to 15 if needed.
- 4 team pool OR
- 3 team pools will follow the play schedule.
 - You will be playing the teams from the opposite 3 team pool to get 3 matches
 - Tiebreakers will be used to determine 1st-3rd in your pool
 - We are using tiebreakers to determine 2nd and 3rd seeds for bracket play so this format will assist with that since all matches will count
- SEE BRACKET PLAY seeding description.
 - Sets & Points will be important for ALL teams during pool play since tiebreakers will be used for some bracket seeding depending on your pool finish.
 - Team will be ranked in their pool 1st and THEN the 2nd and 3rd place teams will be ranked amongst the other 2 and 3 seeds from the other pools to determine pool seeding.

Bracket Play

Due to court setup at Riverside the brackets will be seeded as follows to allow for less wait time and better bracket flow, so teams aren't waiting 2 hours to play, and final matches aren't starting at 7pm.

- **Teams MAY move to adjacent site after pool play, please transition as quickly as possible.**
- Teams finishing 1st after pool play will be placed into the single elimination Championship Bracket
- Teams finishing 2nd after pool play will be ranked 1-8 of the 2 seeds using tiebreakers. Match percentage, set percentage and then points.
 - Top 2- 2 seeds will be placed into the Championship Bracket
 - Next 4-2 seeds will be placed into the Silver Bracket
- Teams finishing 3rd after pool play will be ranked 1-8 of the 3 seeds using tiebreakers. Match percentage, set percentage and then points.
 - Top 4-3 seeds will be placed into the Silver Bracket
 - Bottom 2-3 seeds will be placed into the Bronze Bracket
- Bracket seeding may be adjusted if teams from same pool are seeded to play in round 1 or 2 after tiebreakers for 2 and 3 seeds.
- Teams finishing 4th will be placed into the single elimination Bronze Bracket
- All bracket matches are best 2/3
- Prizes will be given out to overall 1st place and 2nd place

Teams will only play teams in the opposite pool and will not play any teams in their own pool. This will allow for 3 team pool teams to get 3 matches like the 4 team pools

Since we are doing tiebreakers for seeding into bracket play for some teams this format for 3 team pools will flow right into the bracket format.

It is possible for teams to have similar match or set records in pool play and ranking in pool often will depend on points.

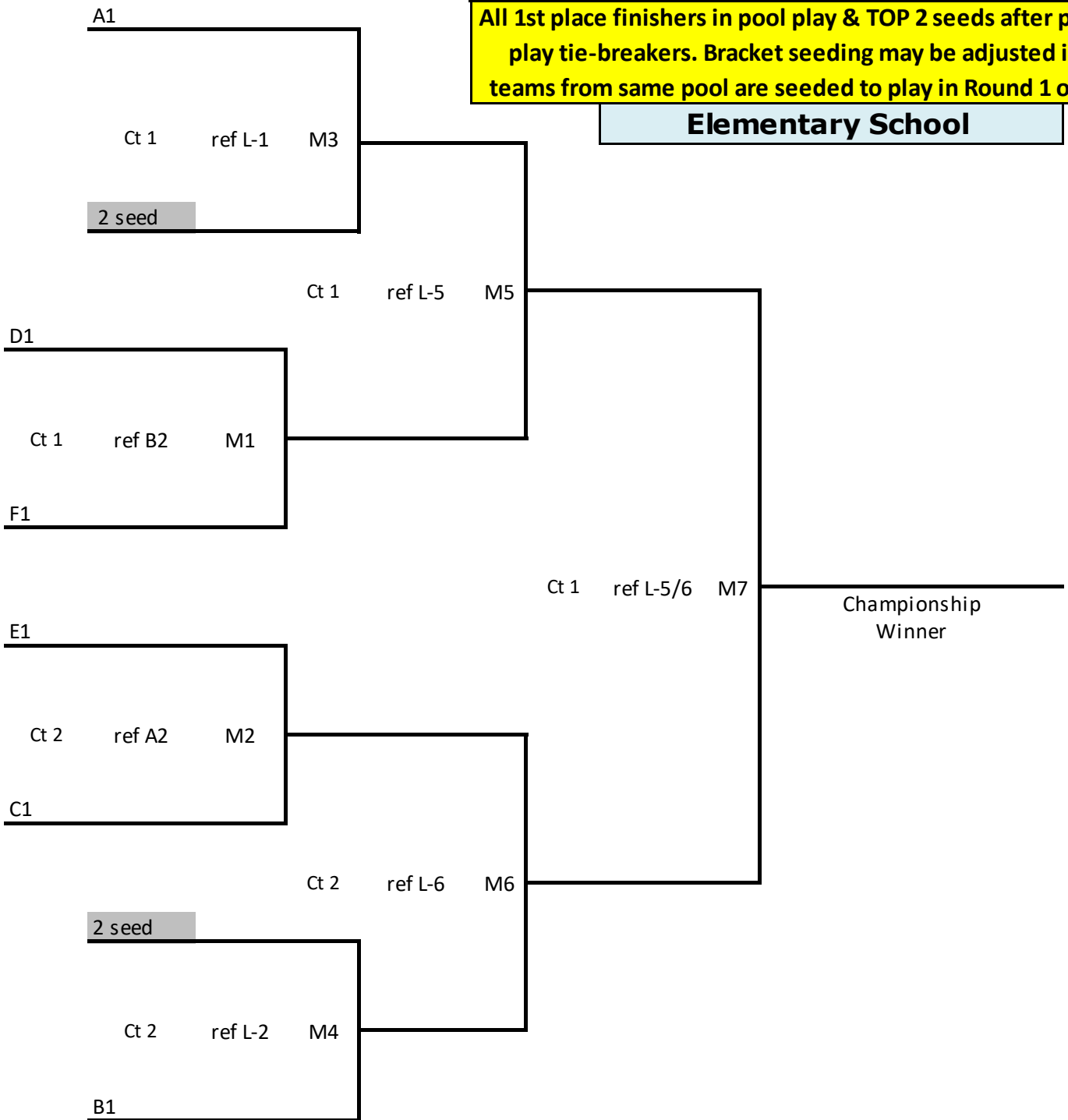
Team will be ranked in their pool 1st and THEN the 2nd and 3rd place teams will be ranked amongst the other 2 and 3 seeds from the other pools to determine pool seeding.

It is still important to remember tiebreakers will be used to determine 1st-3rd in pool play since you aren't playing head-to-head matches for 2-way ties.

Championship Bracket

All 1st place finishers in pool play & TOP 2 seeds after pool play tie-breakers. Bracket seeding may be adjusted if teams from same pool are seeded to play in Round 1 or 2

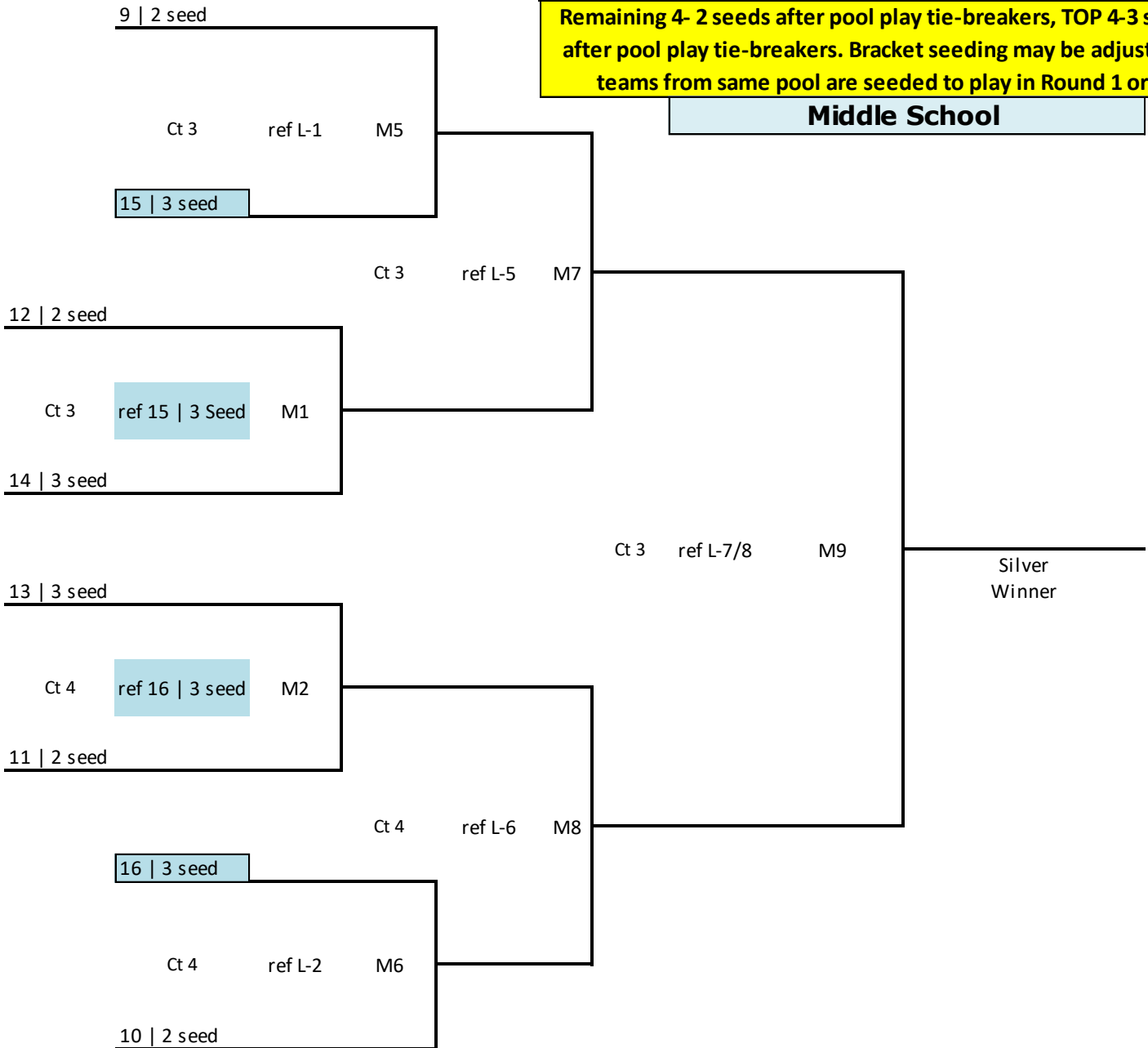
